

V series PCB Update, for appliances produced post 1 January 2004

Please be advised that an updated Printed Circuit Board (PCB) has been introduced on all V-series water heaters as of the 1 January 2004 production run.

To identify cartons containing updated appliances look for a double outlined circle (1. Fig.1) or appliance serial numbers that have production dates post 1 January 2004 eg. 04. 01-xxxxxx (2. Fig.1), the same serial numbers located on the appliance data plates may be used to identify unpacked appliances.

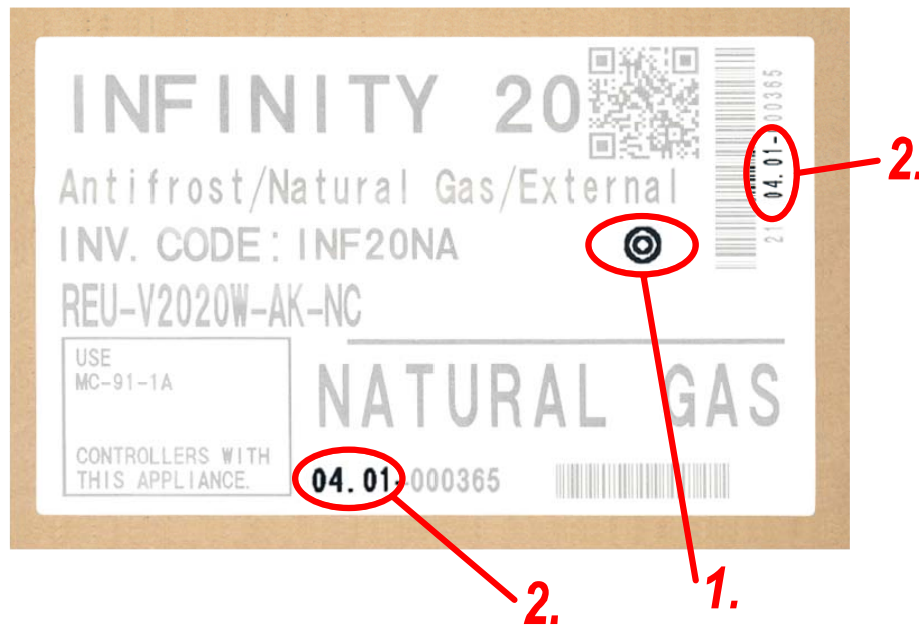

Spare part PCBs can be identified by a yellow dot on the side of the PCB assembly as shown in Fig.2.

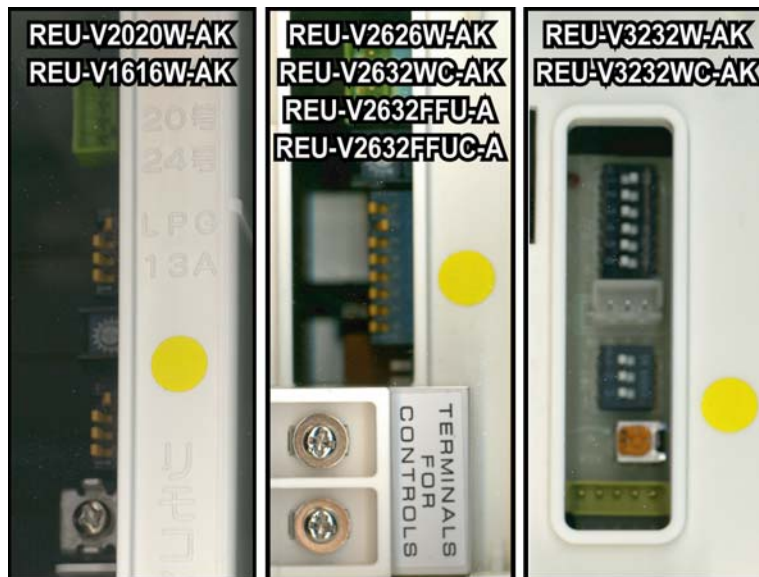

PCB update operational changes

- The key operational change that has been implemented by the PCB update, is the ability of V2 series water heaters (REU-V2020W-AK, REU-V1616W-AK) to be able to use Deluxe controllers (MC-70-2A and BC 70-2A).
- Enables 50° Electronic-lock function (not applicable on REU-V3232W-AK or RUE-V3232WC-AK models).
